August Charity of the Month: Marie Curie



Marie Curie is an organisation which provides hospice care and support for anyone with an illness they are likely to die from. It also supports those close to them, and campaigns for better support for dying people. Established in 1948 (the same year as the NHS) the charity supported over 66,000 people through its nursing services, hospices and support line calls in the financial year 2022/23. The charity runs dedicated Hospices and its information and support service is used more than 1.2 million times per year. Marie Curie is the largest charitable UK funder of palliative and end of life care research.
